How will you help me support my child's learning?

The progress of all children is carefully assessed, monitored and discussed in progress meetings between the head teacher, SENCo and class teacher.

If any child is not making the progress we would expect, this is discussed with parents and support is put into place. Class Teachers will be able to make suggestions about how best to support your child's learning. Parents' evenings are held in the autumn and spring terms and parents receive a written report in the summer term. If there are any concerns about a child's progress between these times teachers will contact the child's parents. It is always helpful to share medical information regarding your child if this will have an impact on your child's learning. Most professionals send a copy of their report to the school outlining recommendations if necessary.

All children have regular individual meetings to discuss their learning with their class teacher.
