PHONICS - Phoneme spotter 'er'

You need- a copy of the phoneme spotter story- see below. This can be printed off, written out by an adult or read on screen. Use a felt tip pen to highlight the 'er' letters. Remind children this is Phonic Fairy 'er,er, what's for dinner' If this is too challenging at the moment for your child, you can do a much simpler version looking for different letters they need to practise in any book.

Maths - Cake Tin Addition

You need-muffin/cake tin, chalk pen or pencil and paper, small objects to help with counting

Write a simple number sentence in the tin.

Use small objects to help find the total.

Can you child do this independently?

Do they spot any patterns?

Are there any additions that they can do without using fingers or objects?

Focus on addition to 10 at the moment- we want the children to become efficient at recognising number facts to 10

Paint/draw/make a picture to fit the music.






The Mermaid in the River




In the north, was a town. Perth was the town.
