100% of Parents/Carers agreed that their child is taught well at Meldreth Primary School. Parents believe that for Meldreth to be even better still, it should encourage better communication between parents and staff particularly around parental concerns. We will continue to invest in excellent and inspirational teaching and learning.

You said

"I would like to see procedures in place to safeguard the learning of the majority well-behaved pupils from the disruption caused by a few high-risk pupils."

Our monitoring has also identified this. We have extended our nurture provision for pupils and this year all staff have had the latest positive behaviour training available. Additional staff have been employed to support in classes where there are high levels of need and senior leaders and our SENCo are monitoring and liaising with other services to ensure that pupils have the best support possible.

You said

"I would like more regular feedback other than 2 parents evenings a year."

This is important to us too, this year we have introduced Tapestry Online Learning Journal in Robin class and [class blogs](#) in other classes to share the learning that is happening in school more effectively.

Our school re-design, due to be completed in October 2018, will allow all parents to deliver and collect children from their classroom door and chat to class teachers.

We always aim to telephone you when we have a concern and follow up any concerns you raise with us via email.
