Early Years Maths in Action

COVID-19 cases are high throughout most parts of the UK, and all four nations of the UK have brought in further restrictions aiming to control the pandemic. But unlike the lockdowns in the Spring, we are staying open this time around. We have been asked to share <u>this video</u> where Chief Inspector Paul Rogerson from the Neighbourhood Policing Team at Cambs Constabulary talks about Lockdown II and what the regulations mean for parents.

- You should be making essential journeys only
- Children should be going straight to and home from school with no congregating in play areas
- Families must ensure that they are socially distancing from others
- School bubbles don't count out of school
- The rule of 6 no longer applies, and
- Play areas are open for exercise with members of your family or one other person only.

We ask that you follow this guidance to ensure that school can stay open for your children throughout this challenging time.

Protecting schools from COVID-19

To provide reassurance to parents at this crucial time, track the spread of the virus and better understand how COVID-19 affects children, COVID Symptom Study have launcheda new School Community feature through the COVID Symptom Study App.

This allows parents and carers to log how their child/children are feeling to a secure school community network, so schools can receive daily insights into the health of their students and make data-driven decisions to keep pupils and staff safe.
