#### **Parent Consultation Evenings**

We are hosting our parents' consultation meetings this term on **Thursday 19th and Tuesday 24th February**. This is an opportunity for you to have a progress update from your child's teacher, and for teachers to provide an overview of your child in school.

# When is the right time to let your child take their first steps of independence? What age are they able to start making their way to school without you?

At our school, staff and Governors agree that all children, up until the end of Year 4 (age 8-9) are collected from school by an adult. In Year 5 and 6 many parents are keen for their children to begin to develop some independence skills, by allowing them to walk home alone or to walk to a local 'pick up' place, where parents collect them and take them home from there. In these cases, we ask parents to complete a form giving us permission to release them from school unaccompanied by an adult.
