Reading is important and therefore we expect you to hear your child read daily and make a brief note of how they got on in their reading records.

To help reinforce the children's phonics lessons ask children about which letters of blends they have been learning and see you can spot around you.

- Add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20.
- Solve one step problems.
