## Meldreth Primary Use of Pupil Premium (2014-2015)

In 2014-2015, Meldreth Primary will be allocated £39,500 for pupil premium funding. We intend to use this to support our children with interventions such as one to one tuition, small group tuition in Y6 and a variety of interventions across the school, residential visits, outings and visitors to the school. In addition to the focused teaching interventions provided to pupils listed here, we also used teaching approaches which close the gap in attainment outlined below.

Nurture Club, (Owls), for Y1 - 4 - daily for one hour
Better Reading Partnerships - Year 1 (3-4 children, intense daily reading support)

Y2 maths and literacy boosters led by class teachers/TAs
First Class at maths – Year 3/4 (2-3 times a week)
Change 4 life club 1 hr per/week
Inference Training – Year 5/6 (2-3 times a week)
Individual and group interventions run across the school in classes for EYFS – Y6 in classes
One to one tuition for children in Y6, either 1:1 or small group
1-1 counselling
Extended Schools Subsidy

In addition to the interventions listed above (and probably not accounted for), we provide a range of interventions across the school that are delivered by teachers and teaching assistants on a daily and weekly basis for pupils identified as needing support. In 2013-2014 this included: Direct phonics, , Talking partners, handwriting and reading support, maths support, Further Literacy Support and boosters where needed in all classes.
