Pupil Wellbeing

I would like to say **thank you so much to all staff** for their support and hard work on our *Pupil Learning and Wellbeing* and *Cambridge Ambassador for Pupil Wellbeing* projects this term. Our aim is not only to better support your children with our findings but also to enhance the support that all children receive in the future through our large-scale research projects.

We have just carried out follow up surveys on your child's wellbeing and resilience and hope to be in a position to communicate further in the New Year. Preliminary data shows that **our children have scored significantly higher than other schools for Wellbeing and Metacognition**, compared to over 62,000 pupils across the country.

Staff are now in the process of deeper individual analysis to provide further support for pupils where this is necessary. It has been a tough term, and I know that staff will use further findings to support your pupils' wellbeing in 2021.


IMPORTANT contact school immediately if you have symptoms over the holiday....

Symptoms begin	Contact school immediately?	
Between Mon 14 th & Fri 18 th Dec	Yes	School will notify families who may have been in contact. You will have to self-isolate for 14 days
On Sat 19 th Dec	Yes	School will notify families who may have been in contact on Thurs 17 th and Fri 18 th Dec. You will have to self-isolate for 14 days
On Sun 20 th Dec	Yes	School will notify families who may have been in contact on Fri 18th Dec. You will have to self-isolate for 14 days
After Monday 21st Dec	No	Unless testing was delayed following onset of symptoms, there is no need to contact school.
