FREE Science Club

Bruntwood SciTech are teaming up with their partner, the <u>Cambridge Science Centre</u>, to run a series of monthly STEM clubs for local children aged between 7-11, who are either struggling in STEM subjects or could benefit from the extra support. Starting on the 30th May, the club will run for 6 sessions on the last Thursday of the month between 4pm - 6pm. Registration is required as there are **30 spaces available**, but **it is free to attend** and snacks and refreshments will be provided for the children.

The sessions will be run by the Cambridge Science Centre team, so they will be fun and interactive, allowing children to learn and develop their skills and knowledge of STEM through engaging activities, with the final hour of each session hosted by a scientific company either based at the site or from a neighbouring science park.
