Phonics Check

Who is it for?

All **Year 1 pupils** take the phonics screening check during June. **Year 2 pupils** who didn't pass the phonics screening check when they were in Year 1 are given another opportunity to show what they have learned in Year 2.

What is in the screening check?

The check comprises of a list of 40 words and nonsense words. It assesses phonics skills and knowledge learnt in reception and Year 1. Pupils read one-to-one with their class teacher and they are asked to sound out a word and blend the sounds together. The check is very similar to the tasks the pupils complete during phonics lessons. In total, the check lasts approximately 10 minutes.
