Key Texts: Non-fiction texts

English: For the next few weeks we will look at report writing. We will write a fact file about a London landmark. We will study Queen Elizabeth I and write a biography. We will also write list poems about kings and queens.

SPaG: We will recap Year 1 & 2 spelling rules. Commas in a list and expanded noun phrase (adjectives).

Maths: In maths, we will focus on addition and subtraction. The children will use addition and subtraction facts to 20 and identify related facts to 100. We will discuss the commutativity of addition and the children will solve word problems.

Science: This term we will be looking at uses for everyday materials. We will continue this in to the second half term.

History: Studying Queen Elizabeth I and comparing her with Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II.

RE: Harvest & Thanksgiving

PSHCE: Financial capabilities

Music: The children will continue looking at 'I Wanna Play in a Band' from Charanga Music.

PE: OAA unit - Trails, Trust & Teamwork

Art & Design: Portraits focusing on Queen Elizabeth I and the class will design and make crowns and Elizabethan ruffs.
