Seas are smaller and shallower than oceans. They are usually located where the land meets the ocean.

There are 5 oceans:

Atlantic Pacific Indian Arctic Southern



Oceans are constantly moving in patterns called currents.

70% of the Earth's surface is ocean water. The rest of the Earth's surface is land.



Oceans have tiny plants in them which produce much of the oxygen that we breath. This is an important reason to look after oceans.
