


## Blooming Marvellous!



Entry Point: After reading Yucky Worms, we will make our own worm house and monitor the movements and behaviour of

worms.	
English	We will explore and write a variety of poems. We will develop writing skills for simple riddles (Who am I?) and free
	verse.
	We will introduce singular and plural – bush / bushes.
	We will begin to spell words using -ed, ing, er and -est and we will use the prefix un
	We will continue to develop our skills in writing instructions and fact files.
	In phonics we will be consolidating our learning for the alternative sounds used for 'c' and 'g'. We will be learning
	GPC's for: ire, are, tch, oe, ph and revisiting long vowel sounds for a, e, i, o and u.
Maths	We will be covering sharing (division) and fractions for this half term. We will recognise, find and name a half as
	two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity. We will recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal
	parts of an object, shape or quantity.
Science	We will be completing our unit on plants as well as begin looking at Pets and Gardens.
	Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees.
	Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.
	The children will be planting seeds in the school garden.
	Children will be able to identify and name animals found in and around our homes.
	We will be observing animals we find in the grass and the shade.





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Art	We will be focusing on the land artist Andy Goldsworthy, exploring and creating patterns using a variety of natural
	materials. We will continue to develop our use of colour and texture by painting our own version of one of Andy's
	pieces of work.
PSHCE	Working together
RE	Stories and symbols, thinking about key stories in various religions.
Music	Our unit is called Having Fun with Improvisation. We will be using a variety of instruments to explore creating
	melodies and rhythms individually as well as with a partner and as part of a group.
Computing	We will use Purple Mash learn to develop the children's coding skills.
PE	This half term we will be completing our fundamentals and athletics units as well as preparing for our sports day.
Geography	At the farm – We will be exploring farms and why they are important. We will be exploring the features of a farm
	and will be using maps and symbols to navigate our way around a farm. We will be looking at how seasons affect
	farms and we will be comparing farm life with that of people living in a town.
