30 hours childcare for eligible working families in England

Are you a working family and earn over £183 per week? From September 2025, <u>eligible working families</u> can now apply for **30 hours of childcare from Meldreth Preschool** from the term after their child turns 2, until they start school.

Is your family living on a low income or claiming income based benefits?

If so, <u>you may be entitled</u> to claim free childcare up to a maximum of 15 hours during term time. APPLY NOW whilst places are available. Contact Janet on 01763 260432.



Want to wait to give your child a smartphone but don't want them to be the odd one out?

You're not alone! There's a growing movement of parents across Britain who are choosing to wait to give their children smartphones, and it's simple to get involved. The <u>Parent Pact</u> is a way to join together with other families in your school to agree to delay getting your child a smartphone until at least 14 (when they're a bit older and more able to deal with everything the online world brings).

It's all about strength in numbers – if your child knows that other kids in their class won't be getting a smartphone for a few years either, the peer pressure dissolves. Over 100,000 families have signed already, and it's growing fast.

It takes 30 seconds to sign the Parent Pact – and you can see how many others in your child's class, school and county have signed on the live leader boards.
