To help make these conversations simpler, the Children's Commissioner, Dame Rachel de Souza, has published [What I wish my parents or carers knew...](#) - a practical guide for parents and carers on managing children's digital lives. The guide is designed to support families in making confident, informed decisions about balancing protection from online harm with enabling access to digital spaces that are now central to learning, socialising and play.

We encourage all parents and carers to explore this resource and continue working with us to support children's wellbeing, both online and offline.

**Preschool News** This week at preschool, children enjoyed high-quality, play-based learning; in the Caterpillar Room, children explored the topic "People Who Help Us", sharing photos from home and learning about emergency services through engaging, hands-on activities, in the Butterfly Room, the new topic "Stepping into Spring" was introduced, with children exploring weather, growth, and life cycles.

Outdoor learning included games such as the traffic light game and large-scale movement activities, supporting physical development, listening, and turn-taking. We were also delighted to welcome a police officer, who taught the children about uniforms, equipment, and how to ask for help by calling 999.
