

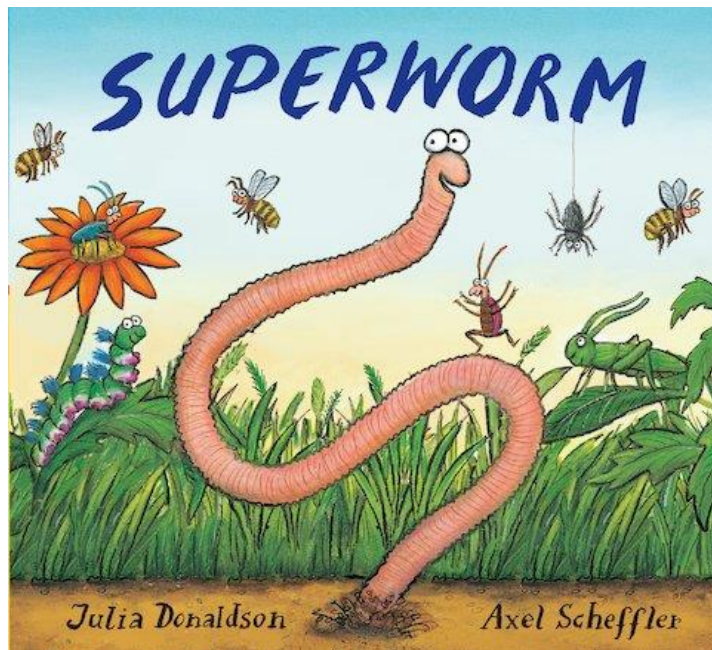

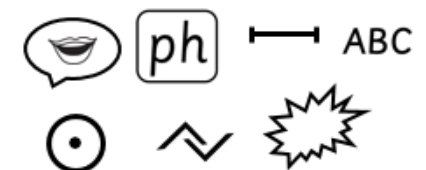


Writing/Topic

Activity

Now you have heard the story what can you tell me about Superworm? Write sentences to describe Superworm. Can you think of some brilliant adjectives to use? Remember to use:



PHONICS: Today we are looking at the digraph 'ph' sounding like 'f'. See if you can read these words -

trophy alphabet phonics elephant dolphin

Activity - Today you are going to design your own phone. You can make it, draw it, paint it, build it... it is entirely up to you. You are going to explain how it works and how you made it later in your show and tell.

MAGNIFICENT MATHS - Money (recognising coins)

Activity 1

Ask your adult for some coins (one of each if possible). See if you can put the coins in to order of value from 1p to £2.

Activity 2

Now draw around each of the coins using a pencil. Write the value inside each of the coins.

Activity 3

At the bottom of the signpost is a piggy bank. Can you use your coins to cover each of the values shown in the circles i.e. 1p needs to cover the 1p circle.

Today we are going to learn about coins and their values. Some coins are valued as pence and others are valued as pounds. These are the symbols:

pence = p

pounds = £

There are 100 pennies in one pound.



PE time/outdoors activity

Today you are going to work on balancing. Things for you to try:

Try balancing on your - bottom, back, tummy, feet, hands and feet. Can you balance on one hand and one foot?

Explore different safe places around your home and garden to balance. If you are going on a family walk maybe you could practice balancing somewhere.

Show and Tell

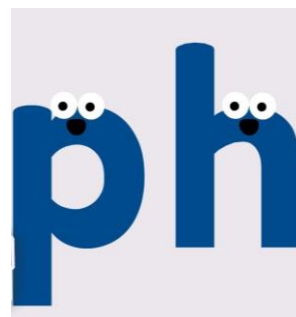


Today you are going to talk about the phone you designed for your phonics task. Present it to your family. You can have up to three questions to answer about your phone once you have finished talking about it.
