University of Cambridge parental research

Between November 2021 and January 2022, we are recruiting 12 fathers and 12 mothers of at least one child aged 7-11 years old. Parents who volunteer to participate will be asked to take part in a 45 to 60 minute interview with a



researcher from the University of Cambridge via Zoom, during which they will be asked to talk about how their physical activity has changed as their children have moved from infancy to primary school.

Studies suggest that parents of younger children (under 5s) are less active than parents with older children. Considering the many physical and mental health benefits of physical activity, we want to find out what changes in the physical activity behaviours of parents as their children move from infancy to primary school to find ways to increase the physical activity levels of parents of younger children. We also want to find out whether and how experiences differ for mothers and fathers. We have created the Parental Experiences of Physical Activity study to hear about the experiences of physical activity of both fathers and mothers.

All participants will be given a £15 voucher to thank them for taking part.

School Health & Safety Reminders

All children need **appropriate shoes (not boots)** whist in school that support their growing feet and outdoor play safely. We find that this does reduce the number of accidents that children have in school.

We expect that **long hair is tied back** for school to keep you child safe in PE lessons, science and technology lessons as well as to help reduce the risk of head lice spreading in the classrooms.

Children should not come to school wearing nail varnish, tattoos/transfers, make up or jewellery, except stud earrings.

Earrings should not be worn on PE days, or if this is not possible, covered with tape.

Children should ensure that they have **jumpers or cardigans to wear in the classrooms**. As we are required to ensure sufficient ventilation to the classrooms, doors and windows are often open which means that the rooms are slightly cooler than normal.



Please do continue to inform us if you feel that your child has COVID symptoms and needs to take a PCR test. We will continue to update our website with any classes where children have COVID symptoms and will inform you if there is a positive case in your child's class.
