

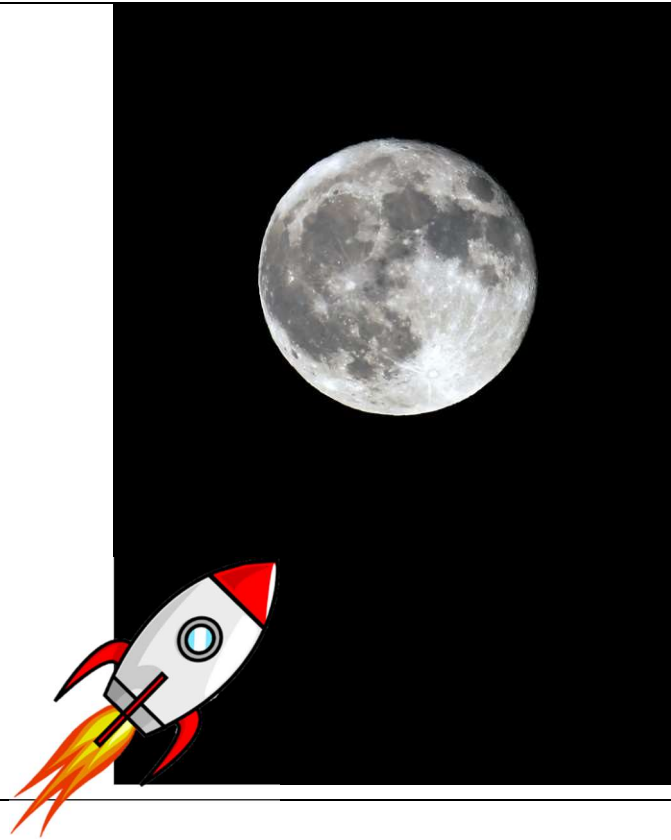

Have a go on your bike, scooter, skate-board or go for a run/walk.



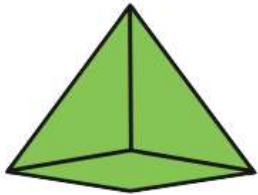

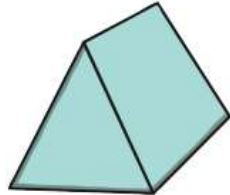

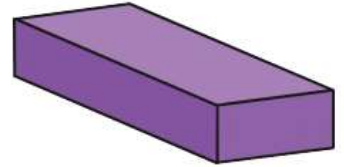
square-based pyramid



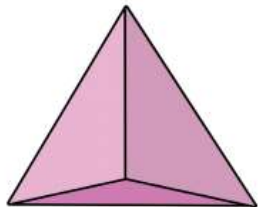
triangular prism



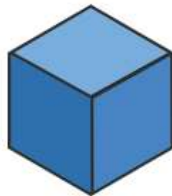

# Triangular Prism Net

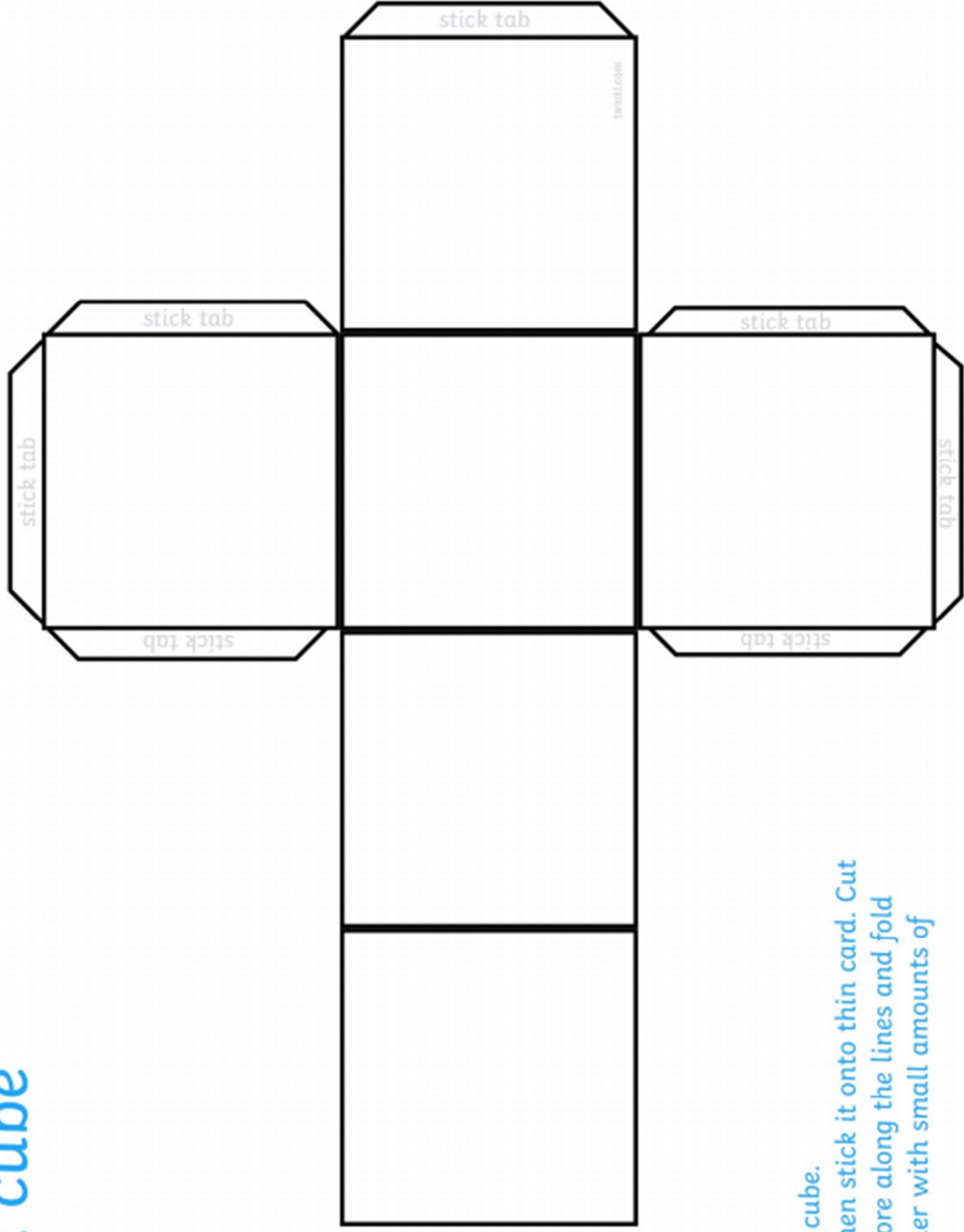


# Cuboid Net

What materials might it be made from?

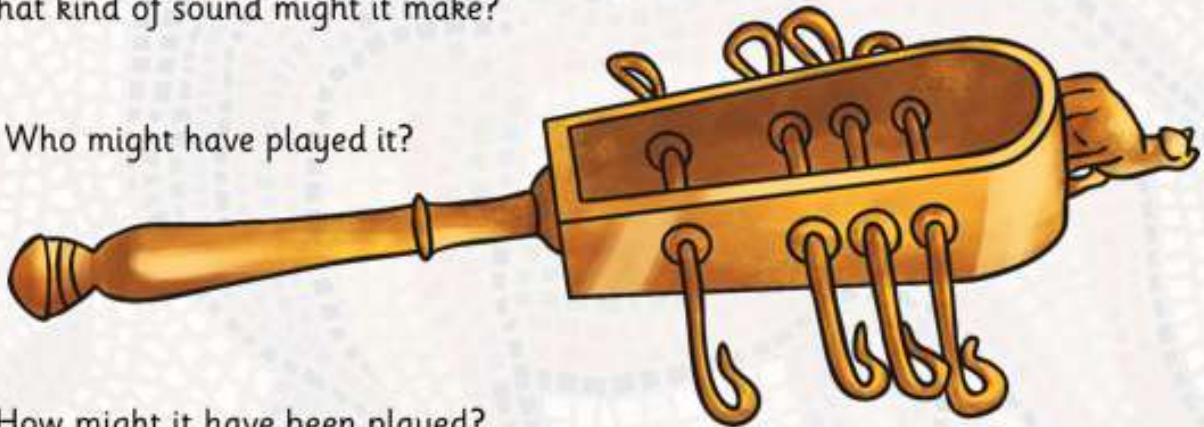
What kind of sound might it make?
