

Growing Our Future

For the first two weeks of term, Wren Class will explore *The Secret Sky Garden* by Linda Sarah and Fiona Lumbers. The themes of this text are a child's desire to impact the natural world, rewilding and community.

Our initial maths work will focus on place value to and across 100.

This unit will continue in to our next topic.

In English, the children will recap their non-negotiables from Year 1 and work on accurately punctuating sentences.

In science, the children will discuss what a scientist is and look at famous scientists and their impact on our world.



In history and geography, our local area will be our focus.

We will look at local history and explore the geography of the UK.

In art and design, the children will construct kites and begin to discuss what makes art important.

Our computing focus will be understanding technology and looking at how we use technology at home and in school.

Our PSHCE unit is rights, rules and responsibilities. We will explore this through discussions about pupil leadership roles in the classroom and around school.

Our first PE sessions will cover fundamental skills. We will look at ball skills including rolling, catching and bouncing.

Mrs Morris will take the class for RE, music and show and tell on a Thursday afternoon. They will look at the big question what communities do I belong to? and in music they will complete the Charanga unit Hands Feet Heart.
