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Year 2 Sex and Relationships Education

Dear Parent/Carer,

We will shortly be beginning some work in Year 2 about 'Growing and Changing'. This work forms part of an ongoing programme of Sex and Relationships Education, which we deliver throughout the school. Our 'Growing and Changing' topic covers some elements of Science, Relationships Education and Health Education.

Your children will be engaging with the following questions as part of this work:

- How do babies change and grow?*
- How have I changed since I was a baby?*
- What's growing in that bump?*
- What do babies and children need from their families?
- Which stable, caring relationships are at the heart of families I know?
- What are my responsibilities now I'm growing up?

We encourage you to discuss any of these areas with your children before, during or after our topic, as children and young people say that they greatly value being able to talk their parents/carers about these issues.
