PHONICS - Tricky Word Tuesday

Practise reading the words - *were, there, little, one*

Write 4 of the tricky troll words on a piece of paper and play bingo! (You could also include *have, like, some, come, said* and *so* or any your child finds difficult to recognise)

Practise writing the words (*they, all* and *are*) - use magnetic letters to build them, write them with a stick in the mud outside, in flour/salt or shaving foam, build them with raisins/sweets/breadsticks.

Maths - Money - Coin recognition Match Game

You will need: coins and a piece of paper

Draw around the different coins in different colours on a piece of paper. Write their value in the middle of each coin.

Take the coins one at a time out of a purse or pot and match them to the correct spot. Talk about their value, colour, size, etc.
