#### **Safer School Parking**

School has been approached by residents in neighbouring properties concerned about the standard of parking, particularly in the morning before school starts. As some of them pointed out, it would be very difficult for an emergency services vehicle to reach the school or other properties with so many vehicles partially blocking the road. Please note that Rule 243 of the Highway Code states **you must not park opposite or within 10 metres (32 feet) of a junction**, except in an authorised parking space. **PLEASE PARK SO THAT OUR OLDER PUPILS CAN CROSS ROADS SAFELY AS THEY WALK HOME FROM** 



**SCHOOL.** Please consider parking further away from school and walking further to school. We thank you in advance for parking responsibly.
