## How places were allocated

The coordinated scheme for school admissions aims to offer parents the highest ranked preference it is possible to meet. This means that if you have been successful with your 1<sup>st</sup> preference school, any school ranked lower on your application will not have been considered.

# Please note if one of your preferences are for a school in another county, we may not have heard due to the current coronavirus impact on staffing in other Local Authorities. If you reside within Cambridgeshire an alternative offer will have been made.

#### Over-subscribed Cambridgeshire schools

Detailed below are two tables containing the allocation information for Cambridgeshire schools that either received more applications than places available, or no longer have places available after the allocation process was completed. On time applicants were considered before late applications, as detailed in the First Steps booklet.

The first group of schools, shown below and overleaf, are those where, in addition to the PAN being reached, the reception class(es) has also reached its legal Infant Class Size limit of 30 pupils. This limit, under current legislation, cannot be exceeded. If you have been unsuccessful in gaining a place at one of the schools in this list you are entitled to an **Independent Infant Class Size Appeal** against this decision.
