When Should I Worry



When your child is unwell

When your child is unwell, it can be hard deciding whether to keep them off school. <u>These simple</u> <u>guidelines from the NHS should help.</u> Not every illness needs to keep your child from school but if your child is not able to attend, be sure to inform the school each day of their absence by email or phone. **Please make all dentist and doctors' appointments outside school hours**. If this is not possible, please ensure your child is in school for both registration times so that they don't miss important information shared at this time. **Remember: if you are concerned about your child's health, please consult a health professional.**

Allergy Awareness

Although we recognise that this cannot be guaranteed, Meldreth Primary School aims to be a Nut-Free school. We aim to reduce the risk to those children and adults who may suffer an anaphylactic reaction if exposed to nuts to which they are sensitive. The school aims to protect children who have allergies to nuts yet also help them, as they grow up, to take responsibility as to what foods they can eat and to be aware of where they may be put at risk. Please note that we do not allow nuts or nut products in school lunch boxes.



Attendance Matters

Ours is a successful primary school and your child plays their part in making it so. We aim to create an environment that enables and encourages all members of our school community to strive for excellence. For our pupils to gain the greatest benefit from their education, it is vital they attend regularly.

Your child should arrive at school on time every day our school is open, unless there is an unavoidable reason for absence.

We consistently work towards a goal of 100% attendance for all children. Parents should be aware that it is school policy - in line with our Local Authority policy - **to issue parents with a Fixed Penalty Notice for unauthorised absences whenever this meets the criteria for a fine to be issued**.
