PHONICS - Find and reveal

You need: flour/shaving foam/foam soap, cluster cards- tr fl gr gr tr sw cl br Write some consonant clusters on pieces of paper and put these next to the cushions. Put these letter cards on a tray and cover with flour. If using shaving foam letters will need to be under clingfilm or something similar! Move the flour around with your finger to find the cluster eq tr, now write a word with this cluster (tree). Maths - Shape characters

You need- different shape outlines (these could be made by drawing round objects)

Today we are learning about using correct maths terms for 2d shapes- shape names and their properties straight sides, curved sides, corners. Try to encourage children to use squares, rectangles, triangles, semi-circles, circles, ovals, pentagon and hexagons.


Make a shape picture of a castle, a dragon, a knight or a princess. Children should be able to do this independently.
