#### **Possible Strike Action**

Further to the news of industrial action proposed by the National Education Union (NEU), I wanted to communicate with you about the potential impact.

According to the <u>NEU</u>, members have reported struggling with the cost of living crisis, childcare costs, energy costs and mortgage payments. They explain that, although the government offered a 5% pay increase to teachers, due to increasing levels of inflation, the reality is that the 5% increase is a 7% pay cut.

**Currently we do not imagine that there will be any impact on our school** but I will update you further if this position changes as NEU members seek further professional advice.

### **Free School Meals**

Government Funded school meals are available for all pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. This initiative from the DfE has the purpose of aiding child development, supporting academic performance and improving levels of healthy eating.

#### Do I need to apply for this?

You will not need to submit an application because all pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will automatically be entitled to the free school meal. The meal will still need to be ordered from the school.

However, **if you are on a low income, we highly recommend that you do still <u>make a free school meals</u> <u>application here</u> as it will also allow the school to unlock additional funding for your child, which will go towards supporting their development.** 

Every child who applies for free school meals (because they are from a family on a lower income) can unlock up to £1,320 extra funding for their school called Pupil Premium, which must be spent on supporting their development. So, even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 and will automatically get a free meal, please do still make an application. Otherwise, we will not know that your child is eligible for additional funding.

#### **Parent Consultation Evenings**

This term's parents' consultation meetings are face to face meetings on **Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> and Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> February**. This is an opportunity for you to have a progress update from your child's teacher, and for teachers to provide an overview of your child in school. **Look out for an email notification telling you that booking is live.** 

## **Preschool waiting list**

#### It is never too early to put your child's name on our Preschool waiting list!

Places at Preschool are limited currently and are allocated on a first come, first served basis. The earlier you submit your waiting list form, the more likely it is that we will be able to offer your child a place. Places for September are usually allocated in April. However, if you have left it late, please do still submit a form. We make every effort to accommodate as many families as possible.
