Super Science - Fireworks in a glass

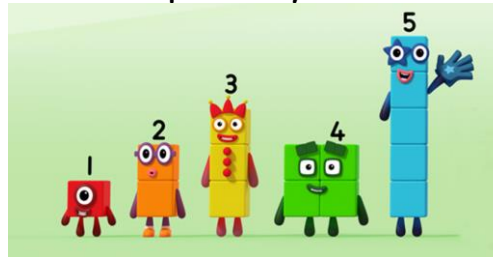
This is a very cool, simple and fun experiment, and also completely safe, just don't drink the water!

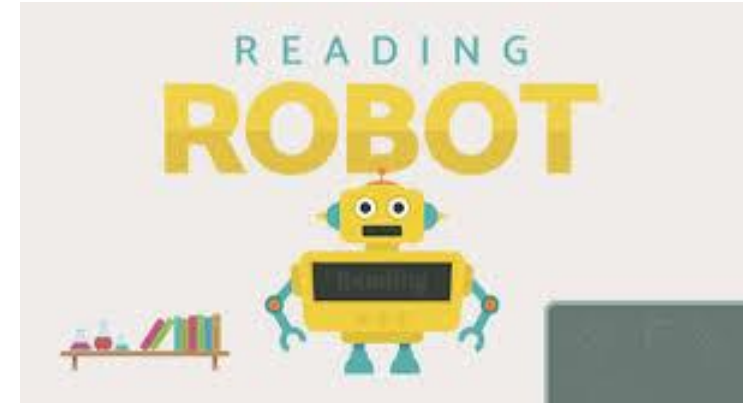

Time to work on those thinking skills. Let's do some sudoku!

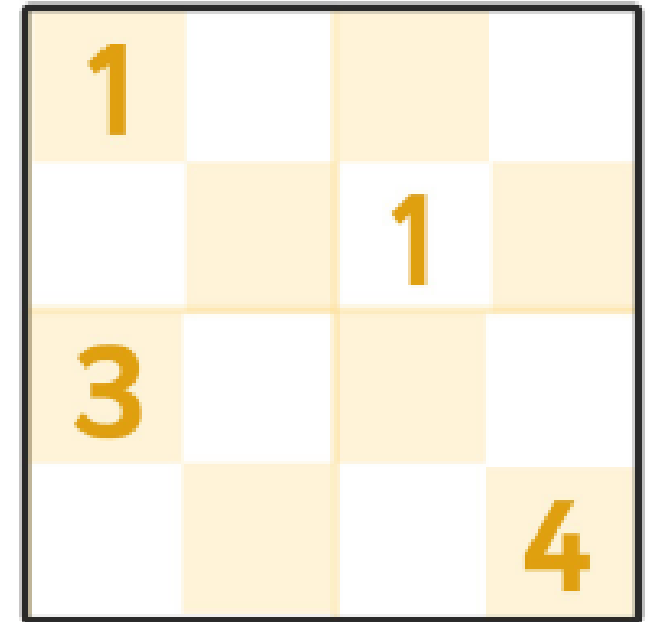
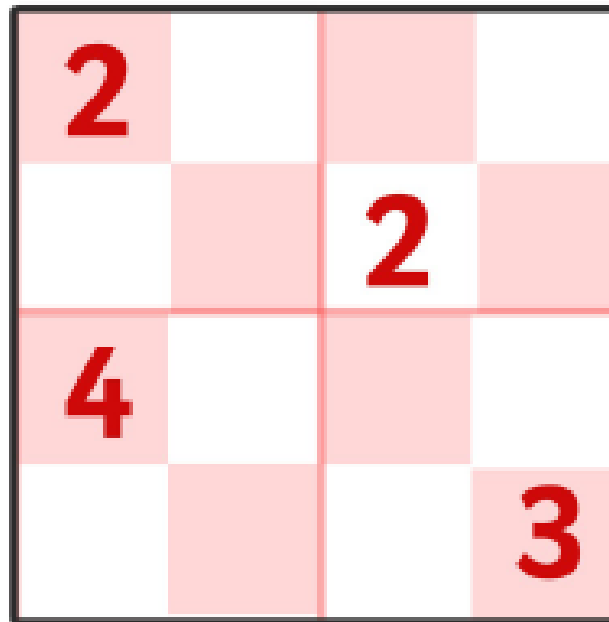
You need to fill in the missing numbers.
