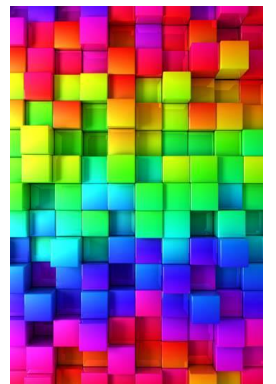

S.T.E.M. CHALLENGE

We are going to test the strength of paper, folded in differently shaped columns, by piling books on top. This is very similar to how columns are used to support buildings and other structures. All you need to do is make a circular, square and triangular column. Start balancing books one by one on top and see which one holds the most. The one that holds the most is the strongest!
