

Your Child's Hand Health

With winter approaching, cracked dry knuckles are an infection risk and can be sore for you or your child. Here is some advice from one of our medical parents to keep it under control in the current climate:



- Use neutral non-perfumed **moisturiser regularly** after hand washing
- Wash hands with soap as it is less drying than alcohol gel
- Pat hands dry after washing rather than rubbing
- Make sure hands are fully dry after washing, **especially around the wrists**
- Washing with **cool water** dries skin out less than hot water
- Sweating will irritate and dry the skin, so avoid overheating
- Moving between hot environments and cold environments will dry out skin
- Keeping hands warm by **using gloves outside** reduces the risk of drying skin

Cycling Smarter

Every year we team up with <u>Bikeability</u> to promote safe riding. Our oldest children began their training on the playground at school showing basic control and bike handling skills. They were required to show that they could start and stop efficiently; look over their shoulders to check for other users; ride with one hand off the bars and show signalling; show control at slow speeds culminating in a figure of 8 and a 'Slow Race'.

Level Two took place on the local roads around the school site. Children learnt to start and stop safely; U-turns; passing a parked car and left and right turns into various side roads and main roads. You can <u>watch them here.</u> The children had a great time completing their training, meaning they are safe to ride on the roads, when accompanied by an adult or older sibling. Safe riding Y6 and remember to show us what you have learnt!
