
What do you know about the circus? Look at the pictures attached and talk about what you might see if you went to the circus or watch Miss Haigh reading a circus story on Tapestry.

Share a book with an adult. Talk about the story together. What was your favourite part of the story and why? Watch Miss Haigh reading 'I see a Circus, you see'


Get Creative some ideas
