


# Perimeter

A **perimeter** is the measurement of the distance around a shape.



## How to Measure the Perimeter of a Rectangle

We use the **length** and **width** measurements of a rectangle to calculate the perimeter of a rectangle.




We simply add up all the length and width measurements to find the perimeter of something.

Remember, all the sides of a shape may not be accurately measured or to scale. If given a measurement, go by that measurement even if it is not to scale.

1. Draw two different rectilinear shapes that have a perimeter of 28cm.



2. Draw two different rectilinear shapes that have a perimeter of 42cm.


3. Draw two different rectilinear shapes that have a perimeter of 72cm.

Find the missing side lengths and calculate the perimeter of these rectilinear shapes.




