2. Find 5 interesting words in the text. Find out what each of those words means.
3. Make a list of any adjectives (describing words) you find in the text.
4. Draw a picture of your favourite character.



Topic/Writing activities for this week: Our topic this half term is called Blooming Marvellous.

1. Go on a Minibeast hunt in your garden. How many different types of insects can you find? Draw pictures and label the insects that you find.
2. Free Write - write a story or sentences about what you can see in the picture right.
3. Listen to the story Superworm read by Miss Jackson on our [You Tube](#) Channel. Write sentences to describe him.
4. Superworm is a rhyming book. Listen to the story to see how many rhyming words can hear. Write any pairs of rhyming words you find down e.g. road and toad, well and tell.
