Our computing focus will be e-safety and looking at the different tools we have in school to support safety online.

Our PSHCE unit is family and friends. We will link this to our learning in RE.

Our PE unit up to half term will cover outdoor adventurous activity. We will focus on teamwork and communication.

Mrs Morris will take the class for RE, music and show and tell on a Thursday afternoon. They will continue to look at the big question what communities do I belong to? and in music they will complete the Charanga unit Hands Feet Heart.
