As you will be aware, we have had a number of positive COVID cases in school this week and continue to closely monitor the situation on a daily basis. We have been following the advice from the Local Authority and local Public Health team and have introduced a number of new measures including ring fencing classes and asking children to test on a daily basis. We will update you on the situation if further testing is required.

Please remember that any positive results should be reported to the NHS and school, this really helps us with our reporting to Public Health. Cleaning throughout the school continues to be a priority and children are encouraged to wash their hands regularly. We have continued to increase ventilation by keeping some of the windows open and we have CO2 Monitors in all classrooms.

During this colder weather, we are trying to get the balance right between 'ventilation' and keeping the children warm. The windows and doors are opened regularly, but we are ensuring that the children remain warm. **Please can you ensure that you label your child's jumpers and coats**; to ensure staff return items to the rightful owners.



Please do continue to inform us if you feel that your child has COVID symptoms and needs to take a PCR test. We will continue to update our website with any classes where children have COVID symptoms and will inform you if there is a positive case in your child's class.

Spring Blossoms

You may have noticed the bulbs that have started to push through around the base of the tree in front of the school office. **This area is now off limits** to allow the bulbs time to flower, frost permitting! Please ensure your child stays to the paths. Thanks again to the parents involved in planting the 200 bulbs, and for your cooperation.
