Maths Task

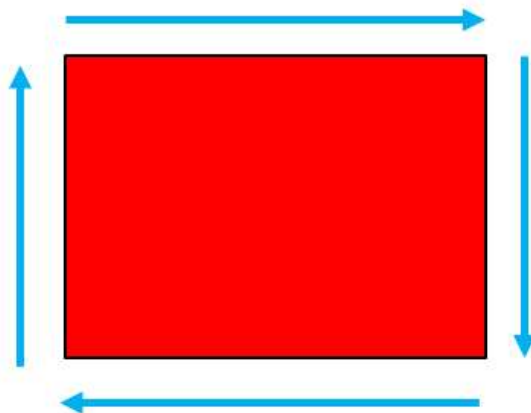


Area

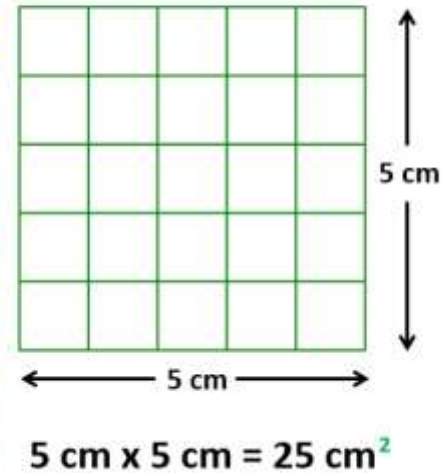
A measure of **how much space** there is on a surface.
Area is measured in **square units**.

Perimeter

A **perimeter** is the measurement of the distance around a shape.



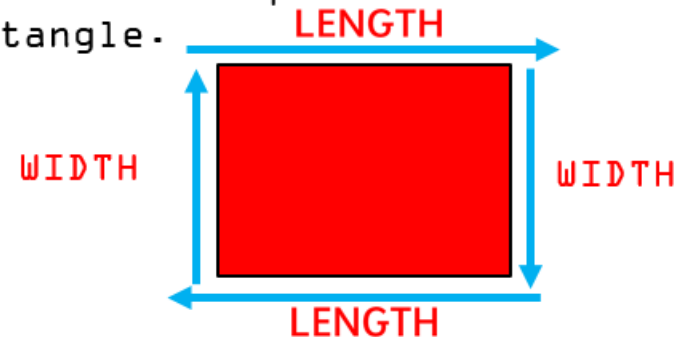
For example...



This square has sides that are 5 cm in length.
To find the area of the square we could count the squares. Or, a **quicker** way is to multiply the lengths of the two sides.
We need to remember to write the **correct unit of measure** –
centimetres squared
cm²

How to Measure the Perimeter of a Rectangle

We use the **length** and **width** measurements of a rectangle to calculate the perimeter of a rectangle.



We simply add up all the length and width measurements to find the perimeter of something.

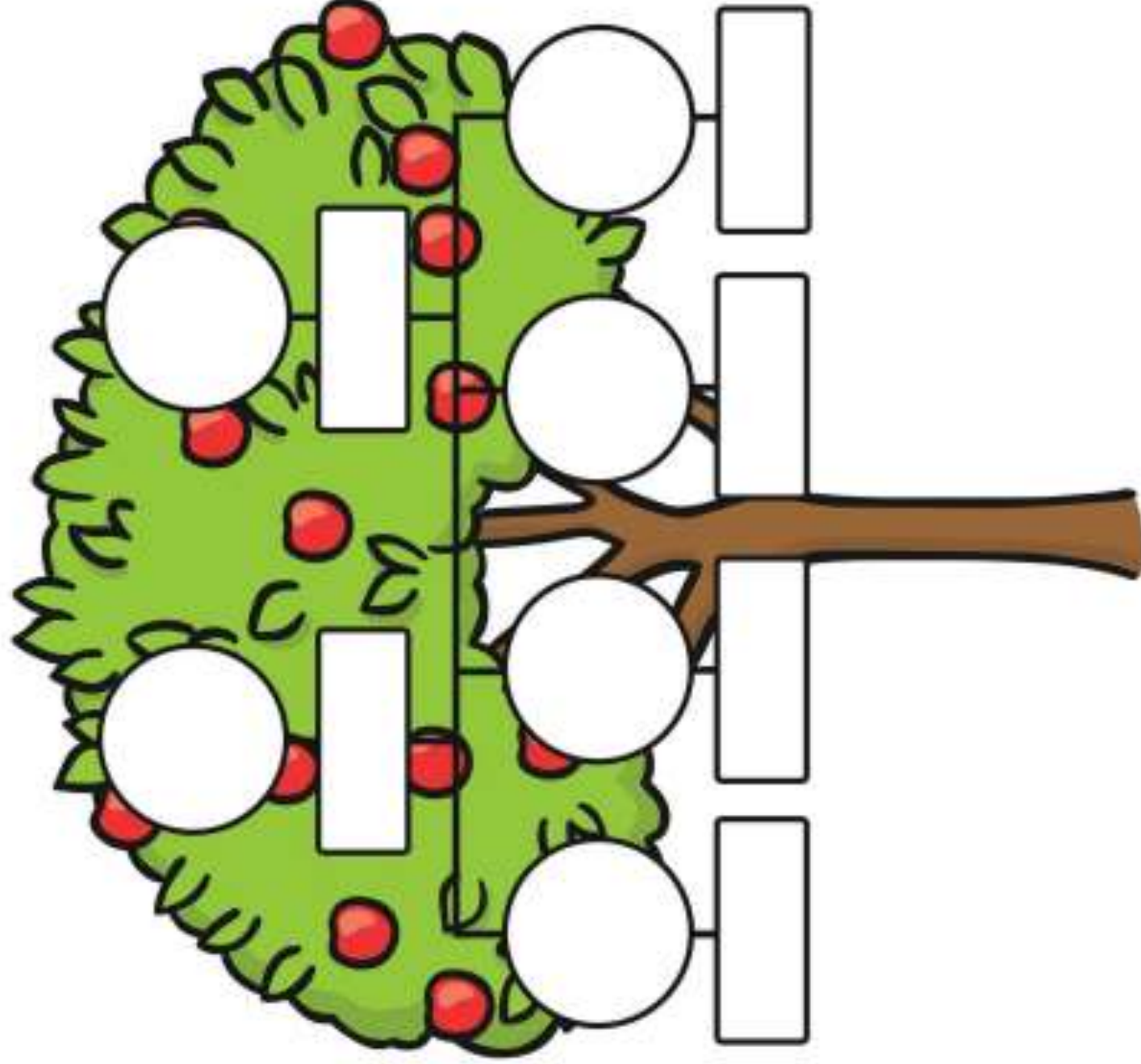
