Punctuation	
ABC	Capital letters for the start of sentences, names and places.
.	A full stop at the end of a sentence.
!	Exclamation marks for exclamation or surprise.
?	Question marks for questions.
'	Apostrophes for showing something belongs to someone and to mark missing letters in contractions (didn't)
,	Commas to separate items in a list and before a conjunction.
“ ”	Inverted commas to show direct speech.

Tenses
Past / Present / Future
Double check your work for...
was / were is / are have / has

Homophones
