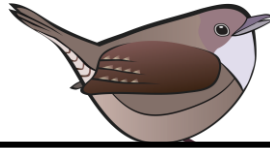

All you need is a Y shaped stick and some wool or ribbons or fabric.

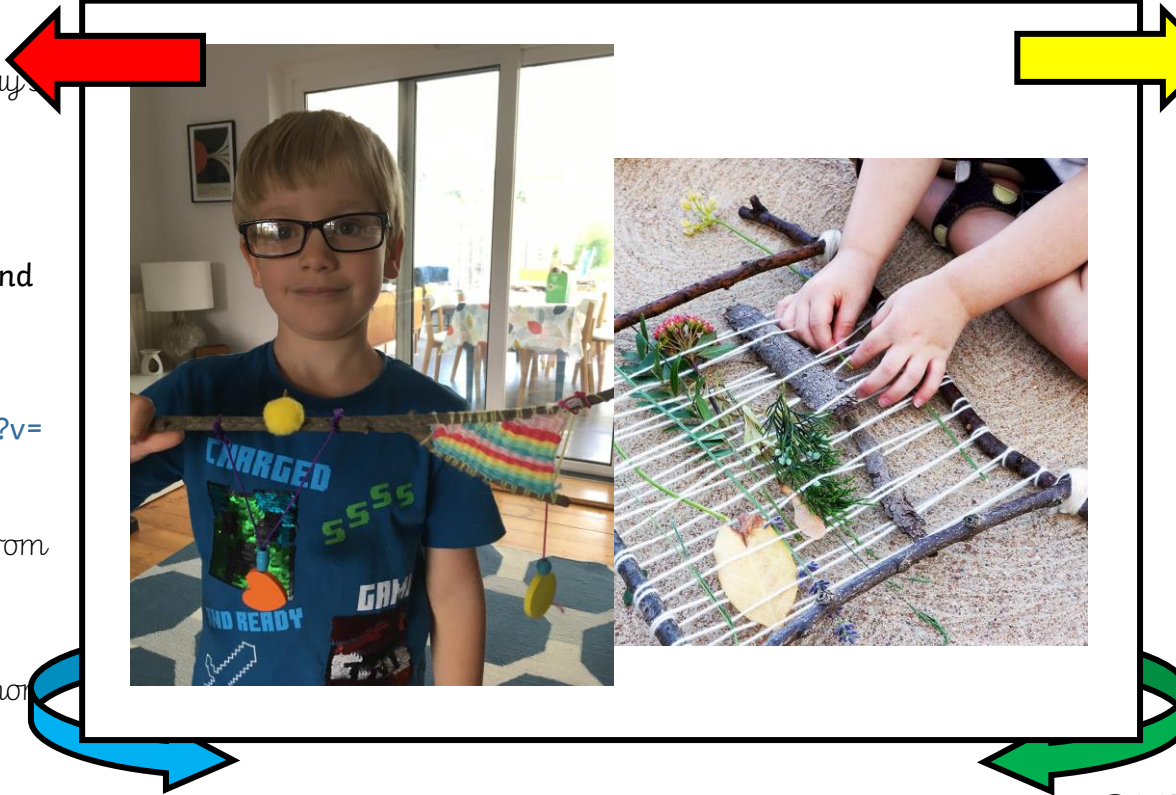

Today we are going to recap using tally charts.

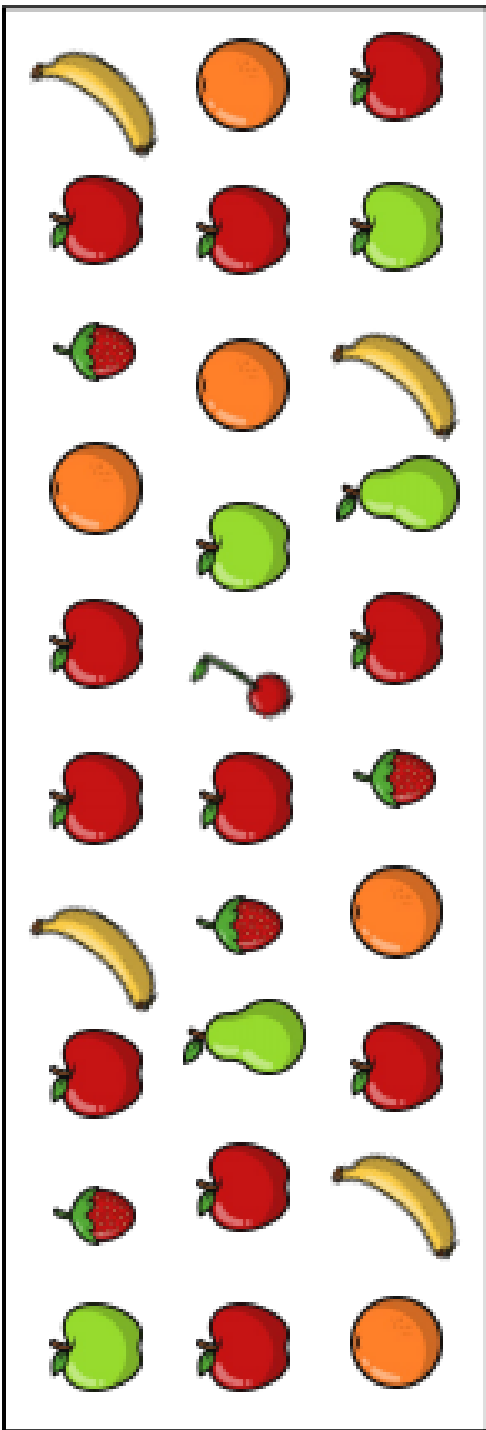

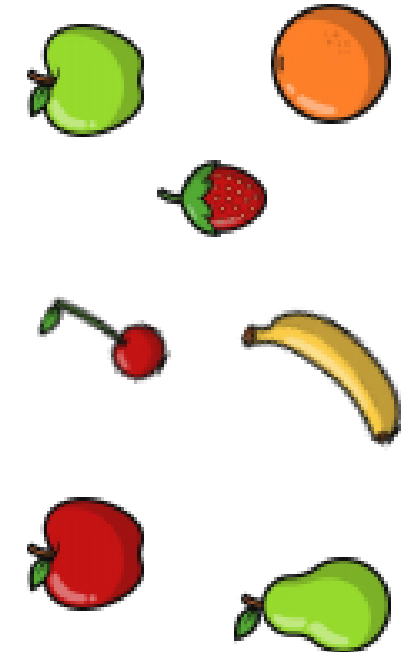
