No Dogs on School Grounds

A gentle reminder that even though we love them, for safety reasons **dogs are not** allowed onto the school premises – even if you are carrying them. Our 'No dogs on school grounds' policy is designed for the safety of children and to protect children with allergies and those who are afraid of dogs. Thank you.



School Uniform

A reminder that the children should wear their PE kit on PE days. If your child has an after school PE club and wants to wear a football kit, they can change into it at the end of the day.

A polite reminder that the children should wear **plain black shoes** on their non PE days. **Hair ties/hair bands** plain green or white, watches may be worn from Year 3 onwards. For health and safety reasons, **earrings** should be plain studs only and removed for PE sessions.
