Think of words that contain the phase 5 digraphs and write them on your paper too. E.g.

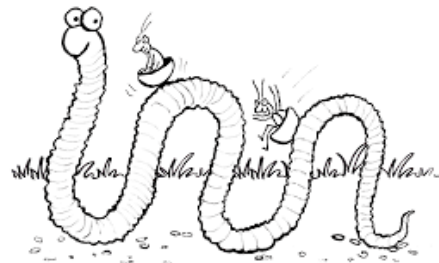
