

You need: coins, cake tin or paper cases

Write a total to be made in each cake section (this could be coin values eg 1,2,5,10 etc) or hopefully the children are ready to move to making totals with coins (so 3p made with a 2p + 1p, or 1p,1p,1p)



1. Find the write coins to match the total in the tin/paper case

Remembering the value of a coin is tricky.
