Our lessons consist of age appropriate activities to teach both the traditional side of Taekwondo (patterns) and the sport side (sparring; as seen at the Olympic Games). There is a large focus on motor skills as well as social skills and discipline as the students move through the grades. Key outcomes are learning specific patterns and techniques at each grade. Once learnt the children will take part in an exam (grading) and show what they have learnt to try and get a new belt (grade). The grading system is: white belt (purple belt, orange belt, brown tag, brown belt added for 4-6 year olds) yellow tag, yellow belt, green tag, green belt, blue tag, blue belt, red tag, red belt, black tag, black belt 1st dan. Students can then progress further by gaining higher Dan grades (1-9). On top of the traditional techniques we look for at a grading, our other examination criteria is that the children have got fitter, more confident and more flexible since their last examination. Our classes aim to improve motor skills, social skills, team working, strength, discipline, self control and perseverance; all of which are looked at during gradings.


