Art: Exploring printing

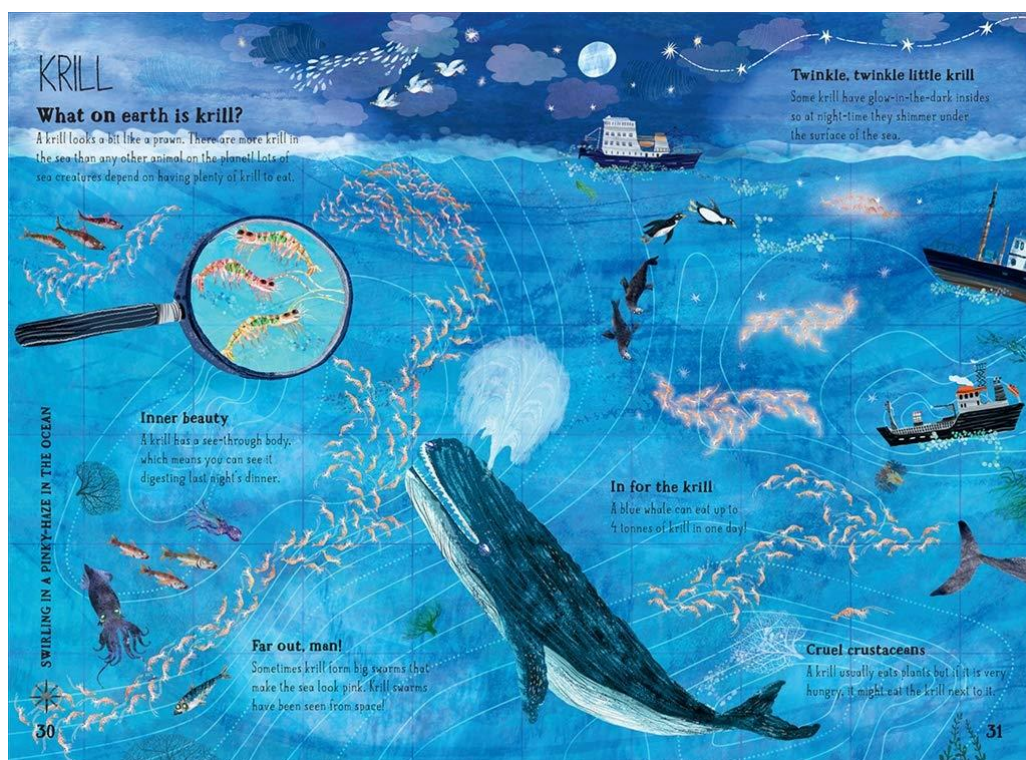
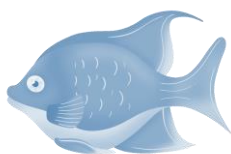
